**11. TRANSFERS AND DISCHARGES**

Self Pay:

The facility will hold your bed for as long as you are willing to pay to hold the bed.


Medical Assistance:

The facility will hold your bed until you waive your right to have the bed held.

Before the facility transfers you to a hospital or allows you a therapeutic leave, it will provide you, your resident representative or legal representative written information that sets forth the following:

- The duration of the bed hold policy applicable to Medicaid residents under state law; and
- The facility's policy regarding resident payment for bedhold periods.

If your hospitalization period or therapeutic leave exceeds the period provided for you under state law, you will be readmitted to the facility immediately upon the availability of a semi-private room, if you still require the services of the facility and are eligible for Medicaid nursing facility services.
