Attachment C – Continued

12. EXAMINATION OF SURVEY RESULTS

Government agencies, at least annually, survey all Wisconsin nursing facilities for compliance with applicable state and federal regulations. The facility posts, and each resident has the right to examine the results of the most recent survey conducted by Federal or State surveyors and any plan of correction that may be in effect to correct alleged non-compliance with those regulations. You are afforded the right to receive information from agencies acting as client advocates, and be afforded the opportunity to contact these agencies. The facility posts the results of the most recent survey of our facility. The facility will post and make available to you, your resident representative or any individual for review upon request, reports with respect to any surveys, certifications, and complaint investigations during the 3 preceding years, and any plan of correction that may be in effect to correct alleged non-compliance with those regulations. The availability of such reports is posted in a prominent area of the facility and is accessible to the public. The facility does not make available any identifying information about complainants or residents.

During the survey process government officials may approach you. You have the right to decline to answer their questions or to ask to have a family member/legal representative, staff member, or ombudsman present during the interview. If at any time during the interview you are uncomfortable with the questions asked or the manner in which they are asked you may request that the surveyor stop the interview.
