PARK MANOR, LTD. RIGHTS OF RESIDENTS IN WISCONSIN NURSING FACILITIES Attachment C - Continued

1. MEDICAL CARE AND TREATMENT

You have the right to select your own personal attending physician and use a licensed, certified, or registered provider of health care and pharmacist of your choice. You will be informed of the name, specialty and way of contacting the physician and other primary care professionals responsible for your care.

You have the right to be informed if the facility determines that the physician chosen by you is unable or unwilling to meet the necessary requirements and the facility seeks alternate physician participation to assure provision of appropriate and adequate care and treatment. The facility staff will discuss the alternative physician participation with you and honor your preferences, if any, among options. You have the right to be fully informed of your total health care status, including but not limited to your medical condition.

You have the right to see your care plan, including the right to sign after significant changes to the care plan.

You are entitled to be informed in advance by the physician, other practitioner, or professional of the risks and benefits of the proposed care and treatment, including treatment alternatives and options, and changes in your plan of care that may affect your wellbeing. This right to information includes the right to refuse treatment.

To the extent practicable, you, your family, or your resident representative have the right to participate in planning care or treatment as well as changes in your care and treatment. This process will include an assessment of your strengths and needs, and incorporate your personal preferences in the development of goals.

You may self-administer drugs if the interdisciplinary team has determined that this practice is safe. You have the right to request, refuse, and/or discontinue treatment, to participate in or refuse to participate in experimental research, and to formulate an advance directive.

Except in a medical emergency, we will consult with you and notify your attending physician, resident representative or any designated family member when there is:

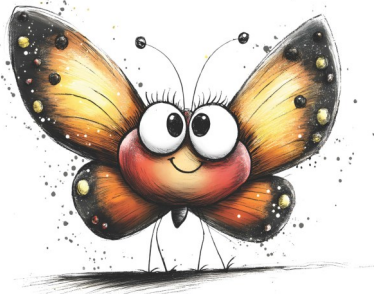
- An accident in which you are involved, which results in an injury to you and has the potential for requiring physician intervention.
- A significant change in your physical, mental or psychosocial status in either life threatening conditions or clinical complications.
- A need to alter your treatment plan significantly including a need to discontinue or change an existing form of treatment due to adverse consequences, or to commence a new form of treatment.

A decision to transfer or discharge you from the facility.
